Booking System:

We are not selling tickets, however we do need to keep an eye on numbers as we can only seat a maximum 180 people per performance.

- ◆ The free booking system is now open on Arbor, please go to the **School Shop > School Shop Products**.
- ◆ Please note Arbor does not issue a confirmation, but you can see a free of charge invoice on your Arbor account under Payments > School Shop
- ◆ The booking system will close the afternoon before each performance or until seat spaces are all filled at 180 capacity.
- ◆ The booking list will be checked on arrival at each performance. If you do not book, you will have to wait until all booked guests are seated to see if we have anymore seats available.

Parking:

- ◆ There will be no parking available in the school Front Car Park.
- ◆ Please park in the village car parks, or there will be very limited 'parent drop off area' parking availability.
- ◆ Please walk around to the Front Entrance to get checked in. We are unable to let parents enter through the back St. Margaretsbury car park gate.
